

## **2021 ESDCJF Fair Update**

The executive committee has agreed on the following guidelines and schedule for the 2021 ESDCJF so that exhibitors can show in person and we can follow school, county and state covid guidelines.

The 2021 Fair will be offering one day specie shows for in-district (East County 4-H, Grange and FFA) exhibitors only. Class sizes will have a small number of exhibitors in each class. Any show is subject to cancellation depending on the number of entries.

Spectators will be limited to the exhibitors immediate family. Everyone entering the fairgrounds will be required to wear a mask and social distancing must be maintained at all times. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival at the fair. All participants must sign into the fairgrounds

There will be no camping allowed at the fairgrounds this year.

No pop-ups, or temporary shelters will be allowed. The wash rack will be open after weigh in. The grooming area will be available on show day only for each specie and each club will have a designated area.

The bleachers will be utilized for spectators with social distancing between families. No personal chairs may be brought.

All animals will be brought to the fairgrounds by scheduled appointment on their respective show day beginning at 7am.

The shows will begin 1 hour after weigh in or check in is complete.

All market animals will be weighed and then proceed to a pen or tie area. The carcass class evaluation will occur after weigh in for swine, time to be determined for other species.

Exhibitors must provide any bedding they desire and remove it before they leave. All animals will exit the fairgrounds at the completion of their respective show or at the direction of the Livestock Manager.

Pictures will be taken after the market show for the auction in a photo area.

Awards will be given on show day.
